## **Completely Stupid (20 x 1min)**

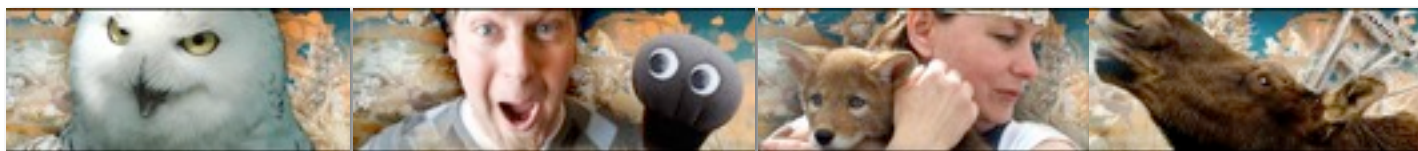
Funny animals live adventures for the less preposterous! Come and discover their stories ... very human!
